OBHC's mission is to demonstrate God's love by providing hope through empowering children and their families to follow Christ. OBHC cares for more than 200 children affected by abuse, abandonment, neglect, or poverty by providing safe and healthy homes where God's love is modeled and taught. OBHC also helps children through its single-mother family program, Hope Pregnancy Center, One Such Child foster care program, and LifeWize curriculum for middle and high school students.
